#### Announcement

Re: Cut-off date for enrollment in Foundation /Intermediate Course for appearing in September 2024/ January, 2025 Examinations.

The Institute has decided that from May/June 2024 onwards, Intermediate & Foundation course Examinations will be held **thrice in a year** in the month of **May/June**, **September and January** from the existing practice of twice a year and CA Final course examination will continue to be held **twice a year** in the month of **May and November**.

Students who are fulfilling the eligibility criteria for Admission to the Foundation course examination i.e registered with the Board of Studies of the Institute for a **minimum period** of four months on or before the 1st day of the month in which the examination is held along with other eligibility conditions specified in Regulation 25F and for Intermediate course Examination i.e registered with the Board of Studies of the Institute and produces a certificate to the effect that he has undergone a study course for **a period of not less** than eight months as on the first day of the month in which the examination is held along with other eligibility conditions specified in Regulation 28G can appear in the next eligible exam.

Students may note that as per the above eligibility criteria -

- the last date for registration in Foundation Course for appearing in September 2024 Examination is 1st May 2024.
- the last date for registration in Intermediate Course for appearing in January 2025 Examination is 1st May 2024 through both the routes.

It may be noted that students who have registered in Intermediate Course either through Foundation Route or Direct Entry Route up to 1st January 2024 are eligible for appearing in September 2024 Intermediate Examination.

#### ICAI Digital Learning Campus Portal: Self-Paced Online Modules (SPOM) SET A and SET B

The Board of Studies of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) has taken a significant leap forward in enhancing learning experiences of the students with the introduction of Self-Paced Online Modules (SPOM). It provides an enriched and flexible learning experience to our students in alignment with the New Scheme of Education and Training wherein students are required to complete the minimum prescribed 40 learning hours of Self-Paced Online Modules in both SET A: Corporate and Economic Laws and SET B: Strategic Cost & Performance Management as available on the ICAI Digital Learning Campus https://lms.icai.org/login. The students may note the following:

- Students who have registered for the Final Course can only undergo SPOM courses at their own pace, anytime and anywhere.
- No separate fee is payable for Self-Paced Online Modules.
- · Students can monitor their learning journey and track the completion status of SPOM on dashboard of ICAI Digital Learning Campus.
- After completing the prescribed number of hours learning students have to appear for SPOM test to be conducted by Examination Department. (A separate announcement
  in this regard would be webhosted by Examination Department in due course).
- Students may refer the Examination announcement-https://resource.cdn.icai.org/75658exam61200.pdf for exemption(s) in SPOM.

#### Students can login at ICAI Digital Learning Campus Portal by using following methods: -

 Login at https://lms.icai.org/login with OTP (OTP will be received on registered Mobile no. with Self- Service Portal (SSP, ICAI only)

2. Sign in with SSP (Login details)

#### Important Instructions: -

- Students are advised before login to read the FAQs carefully. Click here to read the FAQs.
- Students must have Desktop/Laptop with webcam for undergoing Self-Paced Online Modules.
- It is essential for students to have an internet connection with a minimum speed of 2 to 5 Mbps to effectively engage with the topics available on the ICAI Digital Learning Campus.
- Students should ensure proper light for face detection since this platform automatically compares the student's face detection with the SSP profile photo.
- During Self-Paced Online Module (SPOM) learning, students are advised to remain within the frame of the webcam throughout the duration of the SPOM.
